## **ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018-1767**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018-1753, AN ORDINANCE WHICH ADOPTED THE FY 19 CITY OF MURRAY, KENTUCKY ANNUAL BUDGET BY RESTATING CERTAIN REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF MURRAY OPERATIONS BUDGET

**WHEREAS**, the Finance/Personnel Committee met November 20, 2018, and discussed modifying grades and titles within the pay classification plan in the Central Garage, Street Department, Customer Service Department, and Part-Time Tiers for city-wide consistency; and

**WHEREAS**, it was also discussed the need to modify a pay progression program within the Public Works Department and to create a pay progression program for the remaining departments to help the City of Murray become competitive in order to retain and recruit qualified employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee agreed the modified Public Works Progression Program and the new Pay Progression Program for the departments of Administration, Finance, and Planning and Engineering would be implemented effective December 28, 2018.
