	Administrator. As of the time of adoption of this ordinance, the regulatory license fee								
	shall be eight percent (8%) of gross sales of all alcoholic beverages sold by the drink. In the								
	case of retail sales of package distilled spirts and wine, the regulatory license fee shall be								
	eight percent (8%) of gross sales. The regulatory license fee shall be eight percent (8%) on								
	gross sales of package malt beverages."
