## **ORDINANCE 2016-1706**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF MURRAY CODE OF ORDINANCES, §52 SEWERS, SPECIFICALLY §52.05(E)(5)(a) USE OF PUBLIC SEWER TO AMEND LOCAL LIMITS OF POLLUTANTS IN THE MURRAY WASTEWATER SYSTEM IN ORDER TO ADEQUATELY PROTECT WATER QUALITY, WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATIONS AND SLUDGE QUALITY FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the public works committee met on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016, to discuss and reevaluate the pretreatment program's local limits of pollutants in the wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, a re-evaluation of those limits was presented to the KY Division of Water Approval on March 11, 2016 and approved on May 12, 2016.

WHEREAS, the public works committee has reviewed and discussed the following proposed change in the limits of pollutants and believe that the proposed changes are reasonable and necessary.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Murray, as follows:

## **AMENDMENT - ADDITIONS, ASSERTIONS & CHANGES:**

That Section §52.05(E)(5)(a)is amended and revised in the following respects:

## **§52.05 USE OF PUBLIC SEWER.**

(E)(5)(a) Any water or waste containing the following chemical constituents or similar objectionable or toxic substances that exceed the following limits:

Nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

All other sections and provisions of the Ordinances for the City of Murray, not specifically amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be considered amended and shall be incorporated by reference as if fully stated herein.
