INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

RECEIPT AND OPENING OF BIDS

The City of Murray, KY (herein called the "Owner") invites bids on the form attached hereto for POLICE VEHICLES. The Owner will RECEIVE BIDS UNTIL 10:00 a.m. Monday November 23rd, 2015, at Murray City Hall, 104 North 5th Street, Murray, KY 42071. Bids will then be PUBLICLY OPENED AND READ ALOUD at the Murray City Hall. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to City of Murray, KY, 104 North 5th Street, Murray, KY 42071 and bidders are encouraged to mark the bid envelope as follows:

BID-POLICE VEHICLES

The Owner may consider informal any bid not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof, and may waive any informality or reject any and all bids. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered.

QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

The Owner may make such investigations as he/she deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to supply the necessary equipment, and the Bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for the purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such Bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligation of the contract by supplying the equipment contemplated therein. Conditional bids will not be accepted.

METHOD OF AWARD - LOWEST EVALUATED BID

If at the time this contract is to be awarded the lowest evaluated bid submitted by a responsible Bidder does not exceed the amount of funds then estimated by the Owner as available to finance the contract; the contract will be awarded on the bid. If such bid exceeds such amount, the Owner may reject the bids or may award the contract on the lowest evaluated bid with such deductible alternates to produce a net amount, which is within the available funds. The evaluated bid award shall be based on the following criteria:

- a) 25% price
- b) 25% ability to conform to specifications and conditions.
- c) 25% experience of bidder
- d) 25% service availability

Only one (1) award will be made from this contract.

The Owner reserves the right to determine the low evaluated Bidder by durability and maintenance costs over the life of the equipment. This may be done by means of past experience or research. Initial cost may not determine low bid. In case of error or discrepancy in the mathematics of the bid price, the unit prices shall prevail.

QUANTITIES AND LENGTH OF CONTRACT

This contract is for the delivery of 7 Police Vehicles equipped with specified equipment. All vehicles shall include air conditioning, automatic transmission, power steering, power windows, tilt wheel, am/fm radio, factory standard and full size spare tire, full size wheel covers, drivers side spot lamp, black and white

exterior paint or vinyl wrap and deactivated rear doors and windows. All vehicles should also be keyed alike and be equipped with pre drilled headlamps and tail lamps if available on the particular model that is bid. Bidders should include price bids for the following vehicles:

SHIPPING

The Police vehicles shall be delivered to the City of Murray Police Department, 407 Poplar Street, Murray, KY 42071, within ninety (90) calendar days after award of contract. If delivery past this specified time is anticipated, this **MUST BE NOTED IN THE BID DOCUMENTS**. Any and all shipping and/or handling charges to be included in the bid prices.

TRADE IN ALLOWANCE

Bidder shall provide trade in allowance price for 6 Ford Interceptor Sedans and 1 Ford Interceptor Utility which are being removed from the current fleet. These vehicles will still be equipped with center console and armrest, push bar, and rear window guards, all other emergency equipment shall remain in the possession of the City of Murray. All decals signifying the City of Murray or the Murray Police Department shall be removed from the vehicle immediately upon transfer to the awarded bidder. Trade in allowance shall be noted on the bid form. Arrangements to appraise these vehicles can be made by contacting the Murray Police Department at 270-753-1621. All appraisals must be done prior to bid.

OBLIGATION OF BIDDERS

At the time of the opening of bids, each Bidder will be presumed to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the specifications. The failure or omission of any Bidder to examine any form, instrument, or document shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to his/her bid.

Each Bidder is requested to fill out and return the attached vendor sheet, as part of the bid package.

KEYS

All 7 police vehicles shall be keyed alike prior to delivery. This cost shall be included as part of the bid price.

VENDOR INFORMATION

The Police Cruisers offered under this bid shall be new and unused. The unit offered for bid shall meet or exceed the specifications attached to this bid package and shall be considered as minimums unless otherwise indicated. Adequate vendor information shall be included with the bid for determination of meeting the specifications. Any exceptions shall be explained in writing and submitted as a part of the bid package. Vendors may submit multiple bids.

WARRANTIES

Specific warranty information shall be provided for all vehicles and equipment in the bid package.

PRE-DELIVERY INSPECTION

Vehicles will undergo pre-delivery inspection by the dealer. Inspection is to consist of vehicle function checks, accessories check and appearance check.
